Medical Director of Urology Service Line, MHealth-Fairview and Vice Chair of Clinical Services, Department of Urology, University of Minnesota 2020-2023

In 2020 our clinical model across the enterprise was organized into service lines. I lead the urology group along with a dyad partner. Together we direct all the clinical activities for MHealth-Fairview Urology including MDs, APPs and clinic staff. MD employment homes are varied and complex but all report through the service line. Responsibilities include strategy, growth, onboarding, quality improvement, productivity optimization and introduction of new services. Our service line includes 25 providers covering 10 locations. Volumes are 33,000 clinic visits and 4,400 procedures per year. I left this role January 2024 to go back to full-time clinical and academic work.

Vice Chair, Department of Urology, University of Minnesota 2012-2020

Led workgroup to develop strategic plan. Led initiatives in quality of care, vision and coordination for grand rounds and morbidity and mortality conferences. Attended dean’s council meetings when chair was unable to attend. Member of department finance committee. In 2021 the role grew as I took on direct oversight of all clinical services and title was changed to Vice Chair of Clinical Services.

Member of University of Minnesota Physicians (UMP) Finance Committee 2018-present

Review and recommend for board approval all financial activities of UMP. This includes the annual budget, capital expenditures, and investments in new ventures. Annual revenue is \$800M and comes from varied sources including patient care contracts and billed physician services.

Champions for and overseers of tactical and operational initiatives of UMP. Advise and counsel the UMP CEO on strategic plan implementation, partnerships, and contracts. Review and approve new clinical service standards. Communicate clinical leadership directives back to the clinical departments. This is a 5-year non-renewable position.

Medical Director of Urology Clinic, MHealth at University of Minnesota 2018-2023

Lead clinical operations at our university site, including efforts to meet priorities sets by MHealth as well as internal goals. Projects include tiering diagnoses to matching phases of care in COVID era (urology pilot that was implemented systemwide), reducing patient waiting room times, increasing provider availability hours, redirecting surgical cases to ambulatory care center when appropriate, optimizing office visit coding. As Service Line Director I still retain my directorship of our university clinic. I left this role January 2024 to go back to full-time clinical and academic work.

Chief of Urology at Hennepin County Medical Center 2014-2018

Led a division of 1 senior and 2 junior urologists. Hired 1 PA, 1 NP and 1 new urologist. Doubled department RVU (from 1000 to 2000/month), doubled OR case volume (from 40 to 80/month), 40% increase in clinic visits (from 400 to 550/month). Implemented clinic quality improvement including 4-hour blocks, expanded hours, access and level loading. Left this role to assume the clinic director role at the university clinic.
